The Trash schedule for the week of Thanksgiving will be as follows:

The **Honea Path Fire/EMS Department** has strongly recommended that all households should conduct frequent exit drills in the home. Things to establish:

- There should be two ways out of every room
- Establish a meeting place, Example: a tree, a mail box or a neighbor's house
- Once out of the residence stay out! **DO NOT GO BACK IN THE HOUSE FOR ANYTHING**

The **Honea Path Water Department** has strongly recommended that our citizens DO NOT flush wipes, trash, or feminine products down the toilet. Even if these items say "flushable" on the packaging these products are not meant to be in the sewer collection system and can cause overflows, clogs, backups into residences, pump failures, and expensive repairs. Also remember not to pour grease down the drains. Please help keep the drain(s) clean and our equipment operational.

The **Recreational Department** wants to share that the next season for sports sign-ups will be for Spring sports. This sign-up usually starts the 2nd week of February. Spring sports consist of boy baseball ages 4-12 and girl soft ball ages from 7-12. Fall 2020 programs are staying safe and doing well despite the COVID-19 outbreak. Honea Path "Hot Shots", Honea Path Craft Studio, Boy Scouts, and Honea Path work out programs are still meeting in the recreation building regularly.
