Town Hall will be closed April 2, 2021 in observance of Good Friday, will reopen April 5, 2021 normal business hours.

The **Honea Path Police Department** wants to remind you to be aware of your surroundings, lock your vehicles and put away valuables to prevent break-ins and theft. Residents are encouraged to call 864-369-0532 to request property checks while you are away. The Honea Path Police Department has received an influx of reports concerning phone scams. Reports are showing that these scammers tell the recipient they are a Law Enforcement entity, and that if personal information is not provided, they will obtain an arrest warrant. Please be cognizant of the information given through the phone, or any electronic devices. Understand this is not Legal, Ethical, or Morally correct for ANY legitimate agency, and so it is a scam. Stay vigilante! K-9 Riggs and his handler, Investigator Tim Wright have been attending Tracking and Narcotics Training. Their training began March 1, 2021, they will finish on March 26, 2020. Honea Path Police Departments 2nd Kids Camp is scheduled for June 14-18, put this on your calendar. We will have camp applications on April 1st at the Police Dept. We are excited to see what the future holds for our Town.

The **Honea Path Fire/EMS Department** No open burning is allowed in the town limits except when a written permit is issued by the Fire Chief. No burning in barrels is permitted. Fire pits have to be elevated 8 inches or more above the ground, have a spark arresting cover in place during the burn, be 20 feet from any dwelling or fence, and have someone present at all times during the burn. Also, only wood can be burned. If there is a complaint of excess smoke, the fire will be required to be extinguished. For any questions contact the Fire Department at 369-2976 or 369-0112.

The **Honea Path Water Department** reported that there has been a significant increase in sewer calls related to trash, baby wipes/flushable wipes, feminine products, and grease in the lines. **Please DO NOT dispose of these items in the sink or toilet.** These items cause overflows and sewer to back-up in residences, along with costly repairs to equipment. Please help keep the Town of Honea Path protect the sewer conveyance system, public health, and the environment. The Town of Honea Path requires any and all business done in the Town of Honea Path to apply for a business license at the Town clerk's office. Any trash or debris created by contractors, commercial or residential construction companies, painters, landscaping companies, lawn care businesses, land lords, privately owned hired workers, etc. must be collected and properly disposed of at the expense of the business or company. The Town of Honea Path will not be responsible for removal of any trash or debris from residential, business, commercial or industrial districts created by the above-mentioned businesses or companies.

Payable at the office of The Clerk on/or before the 14th of the month. If it is not paid by the 14th of the month, penalty of \$15.00 per account will be added. Bills not paid by the 20th of the current month will be subject to immediate discontinuance of service. If total payment, including penalty, is not received in Town Clerk’s office, postmarked by mail or deposited in the night depository before 8:00A.M. on the 21st of the month, an additional penalty of \$50.00 will be charged. If payment is received after 3:30 P.M, reconnection will be the next business day. There will be a \$35.00 Fee for non-sufficient check or bank draft. Also, you can always pay your water bill at www.honeapathsc.com with a fee of 2.75% with usage of a debit/credit card.
