The **Honea Path Fire/EMS Department** No open burning is allowed in the town limits except when a written permit is issued by the Fire Chief. No burning in barrels is permitted. Fire pits have to be elevated 8 inches or more above the ground, have a spark arresting cover in place during the burn, be 20 feet from any dwelling or fence, and have someone present at all times during the burn. Also, only wood can be burned. If there is a complaint of excess smoke, the fire will be required to be extinguished. For any questions the Fire Department at 864-369-2976.

The **Honea Path Water Department** has strongly recommended that our citizens do not flush trash, wipes/ flushable wipes, feminine products down the toilet, as well, not pouring grease down the drain. Please place the wipes/flushable wipes, feminine products in the trash. This **is not** very good for our sewer it can cause it overflow, and clogs. Please help keep the drain(s) clean.
