### Honea Path Fire/EMS

The Department has to enforce those owners of a building are required by ordinance to post address numbers in a conspicuous place. Numbers shall be 4 inches high on residences and 4 inches high by 1/2 inches wide on commercial property. Numbers must be clearly visible from the street and contrasting color to the building. Failure to comply will result in fines or imprisonment. Also, this could mean the difference between life and death in an emergency situation
